

## Etang Gallet



Since the vidange on Etang Du Bois this has allowed us to select the stock that would be added to Gallet. During the last season Gallet has proved to be the most popular lake by far. This however could be that the lodge is located on its banks and you're never too far away from a chilled beer.

We have now developed this as the runs water of the complex and it is stocked appropriately to give you plenty of action. We will admit that at present we have some double figure fish in this lake but they will be removed to our stock pond as the season progresses or hopefully will have hit the twenty pound mark by the start of the season and will get to stay in Gallet. We know there are carp in the lake to 45 lb and a good stocking of carp above the 30lb mark. The average size however would be 20lb plus. Due to the complex not having any previous angling pressure (by English standards) this is an easy water. However to get the bigger fish out you will have to work at it. The lake is reasonably shallow and the fish show dawn and dusk so location shouldn't be a problem. The lake is also home to a collection of Catfish topping out at the 90lb mark and also grassies have been stocked to 45lb. For the early risers there's the stalking area which has pulled up a few surprises last year.

## Etang Bretain

Although this is the sport fishing lake of our complex at present (Pike, Zander and Black Bass), its now also acting as our stock pond. During the vidange we introduced approximately 400 carp up to about 12lb to grow on. We do however know that the locals have caught grassies in here to 45lb plus and what resident carp are in here we have no idea. So for 2006 season if you want that day off from carping pick up the spinning gear and get in the boat. The locals seem to think the French record for Bass exists here we're not sure but we do seem to have visitors from all over France.

## General

We have constructed a new stock pond within our garden so you will be able to see the future of the complex grow (or feed them if you wish), this however has recently been dug and needs to settle prior to the introduction of the fish.

We trust that this has given you an update of what's happened at Boysaway during our first season. We only started last summer but we have listened to the comments of clients and tried to action their wishes. We want to make this a complex you want to return to so all comments are valid that our customers make, without you guys we wouldn't be here.
